Hizbul Mujahideen terror module busted in Jammu and Kashmir's Budgam, 3 terror associates arrested

Budgam, July 21 : Security forces busted a Hizbul Mujahideen terror module on Budgam on Monday (July 20) and arrested 3 terror associates. Acting on a specific input, a joint team of Budgam police, Army 53 RR and 181 Bn CRPF arrested three terror associates from Pakherpora area during naka checking. The arrested terror associates from Pakherpora area during naka checking. The arrested terror associates have been identified as Mehrajdin Kumar, Tahir Kumar and Sahil Hurra. Security forces busted a Hizbul Mujahideen terror module on Budgam on Monday (July 20) and arrested 3 terror associates. Acting on a specific input, a joint team of Budgam

A case has been registered in this regard under relevant sections of UAPA at Chirai-e-Charief police station and probe has been launched. This module was also busted on the basis of information received from reliable sources. Initial information revealed

that the LeT had activated a module of its members for carrying out terror activities in Jammu and Kashmir particularly in the Jammu region and in furtherance to this, delivery of funds was to take place in Jammu. On this information, a team of SOG Jammu and Peer Mitha Police apprehended one Mubashir Bhat, son of Ferooz Ahmed Bhat, a resident of Sazan Doda. Bhat is a part of the same module and had been tasked by the handlers from across the border to visit Jammu and collect a consignment of hawala money for further use by the terrorists and their supporters.

After 'PM fabricated strongman image' remarks, Rahul Gandhi attacks Centre with 'atmanirbhar' jibe

New Delhi, July 21 : Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday took a jibe at the prime minister by highlighting the achievements of the government during the COVID-19 pandemic. In his tweet, the Congress MP from Wayanad took a potshot at PM Modi for hosting Namaste Trump event, 'toppling' government in Madhya Pradesh. Rahul mocked the Centre saying the achievements of government has made India 'atmanirbhar' in the fight against coronavirus. Continuing his attack on Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led government at the Centre, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday (June 21) took a jibe at the prime minister by highlighting the achievements of the government during the coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic. In his tweet, the Congress MP from Wayanad took a potshot at PM Modi



for hosting Namaste Trump event, 'toppling' government in Madhya Pradesh, asking people to light candle for corona warriors and some other important political developments since February. Rahul mocked the Centre saying the achievements of government has made India 'atmanirbhar' in the fight against coronavirus. "The achievements of Centre during coronavirus time, February - Namaste Trump, March: Toppled government in Madhya Pradesh, April: Asked people to light candle, May: Celebrated six years of BJP government, June: Held virtual rally in Bihar, July: Tried to dislodge

government in Rajasthan. This is why India is 'self-reliant' in the fight against coronavirus," tweeted Rahul Gandhi. On Monday (July 20), Rahul Gandhi had launched a direct attack on PM Modi, claiming that his "strongman image" is "now India's biggest weakness". "PM fabricated a fake strongman image to come to power. It was his biggest strength. It is now India's biggest weakness," Gandhi wrote in a tweet as he shared a video message. In the video, shared just two days after Rahul Gandhi said India will pay a "huge price because of the government's actions", he talked about China's "strategy to restructure the planet". "Chinese don't do anything without thinking about a strategy. In their mind, they have mapped out a world and they are now trying to shape the world... that's what is the scale of what they are doing. That's what Gwadar is, that's what Belt and Road (project) is. It's the restructuring of the planet," Rahul said.

Son stabs mother to death in Delhi's Madangir, smears her blood on his face and body

Delhi, July 21 : A ruthless son stabbed his mother to death on Monday in Madangir area of the national capital and smeared her blood on his face and body. The son, identified as 22-year-old Anjali, repeatedly stabbed his mother, 45-year-old Anjali, with a knife. The landlord reported the incident to the Delhi Police who came to the spot and arrested the accused son. In a shocking incident, a ruthless son stabbed his mother to death on Monday in Madangir area of the national capital and smeared her blood on his face and body. The son, identified as 22-year-old Anjali, repeatedly stabbed his mother, 45-year-old Anjali, with a knife until her scream had subsided, according to the neighbours. The landlord reported the incident to the Delhi Police who came to the spot and arrested the accused son. The police is investigating the case. The incident has left the locals stunned. The mother-son duo lived on rent on the second floor of a house in Madangir. According to neighbours, both of them were quite calm and did not like to meet anyone. At around 12 noon, the neighbours claimed that they heard



gloriously noises from their room. There was chaos in the neighbourhood and people got scared of the eerie voice. When the neighbours and the landlord looked in the room, the son had a sharp knife in his hand with which he had attacked his mother many times. The neighbours told the Delhi Police about this frightening and shocking incident but the Delhi Police arrived quite late citing narrow streets. By the time the police arrived and the mother was stabbed so many times that she died on the way to the hospital, according to the neighbours. The police arrived on the occasion and were left stunned at the shocking incident, there were so many injuries on the mother's body that there was blood everywhere. The police had to wrap her with a sheet. The mother and son had come to live in the house just ahead of the coronavirus COVID-19 lockdown. The son worked as a DJ in a nightclub. This incident has shocked the people of the entire area. The motive of the incident is yet to be ascertained. At present, the entire case has been registered at Ambedkar Nagar Police Station and the body has been sent to AIIMS for postmortem. The Delhi Police is continuously questioning the son.

Miscreants open fire at journalist Vikram Joshi in Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad

Ghaziabad, July 21 : Some unidentified miscreants opened fire at a journalist identified as Vikram Joshi in Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad on Monday (July 20) night. Joshi suffered bullet injuries and was admitted to Yashoda Hospital in Ghaziabad. It is learnt that the attack on Joshi took place at Mata Colony in Ghaziabad's Pratap Vihar. Some unidentified miscreants opened fire at a journalist identified as Vikram Joshi in Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad on Monday (July 20) night. Joshi suffered bullet injuries and was admitted to Yashoda Hospital in Ghaziabad. Police reached the scene of crime quickly and has launched a probe. It is learnt that the attack on Joshi took place at Mata Colony in Ghaziabad's Pratap Vihar. Joshi works at a local newspaper. According to family members of the victims, some boys have misbehaved with Joshi's niece 4-5 days ago. A complaint in this regard was also filed at Vijay Nagar police station but the police did not take any action against the accused boys.

Maharashtra records 8,240 new COVID-19 cases; deaths toll rises over 12,000



Mumbai, July 21 : A total of 5460 COVID-19 patients were discharged from different hospitals after recovery and so far, 175029 patients have been discharged in Maharashtra in Mumbai, COVID-19 count rises to 1,02,267 with 1,043 new cases in the last 24 hours. With 41 deaths in the last 24 hours, the number of fatalities rose to 5,752. Thane metropolitan area near Mumbai witnessed also 255 fresh COVID-19 patients in the last 24 hours, taking the tally to 16028. Maharashtra's COVID-19 tally on Monday (July 20) rose to 318695 with 8240 new cases in the last 24 hours, according to the state health department. The state also witnessed as many as 176 deaths from coronavirus during the last 24 hours taking the death toll to 12030. A total of 5460 COVID-19 patients were discharged from different hospitals after recovery and so far, 175029 patients have been discharged in Maharashtra, said the health bulletin in Mumbai, COVID-19 count rises to 1,02,267 with 1,043 new cases in the last 24 hours. There were also

41 deaths taking the number of fatalities to 5,752, according to city civic body statement. Thane metropolitan area near Mumbai witnessed 255 fresh COVID-19 patients in the last 24 hours, taking the number of positive patients to 16028. So far, 555 people have died of coronavirus in the Thane metropolitan area. In the new Mumbai metropolitan area, 286 fresh cases of COVID-19 cases have been reported in the last 24 hours. The number of positive patients, however, increased to 1712. Two coronavirus patients died today in the metropolitan area increasing the death toll to 345. Kalyan Dombivli metropolitan area near Mumbai, however, saw 427 coronavirus cases in the last 24 hours taking the number of positive patients to 16334. The death toll in the Kalyan Dombivli region has risen to 255. 12 COVID-19 cases have also been reported in Mumbai's Dharavi area in the last 24 hours, taking the total number of coronavirus cases to 2492. Notably, Maharashtra currently has 1,31,334 active

cases, the state health bulletin added. Lockdown in Pune not to be extended. The ongoing strict lockdown in Pune will not be extended beyond July 23, but there will be some restrictions in place in the city to curb the spread of coronavirus, a district official said today, while addressing a press conference. District collector Naval Kishore Ram said the lockdown restrictions, which are in place in the city until July 23, will not be extended. Earlier, a strict lockdown was imposed from July 14 to July 23 after the western Maharashtra city witnessed a surge in COVID-19 cases. Pune district has recorded over 50,000 cases of coronavirus with over 1,300 fatalities so far.
